The CAS in Commodity Professional combines theoretical know-how with hands-on learning experience in a powerful mix. Special attention is paid to the selection of experienced teachers and speakers. This programme prepares the participants to take on management or specialist functions within the commodity industry.

Target Group


The CAS in Commodity Professional is primarily designed for:
