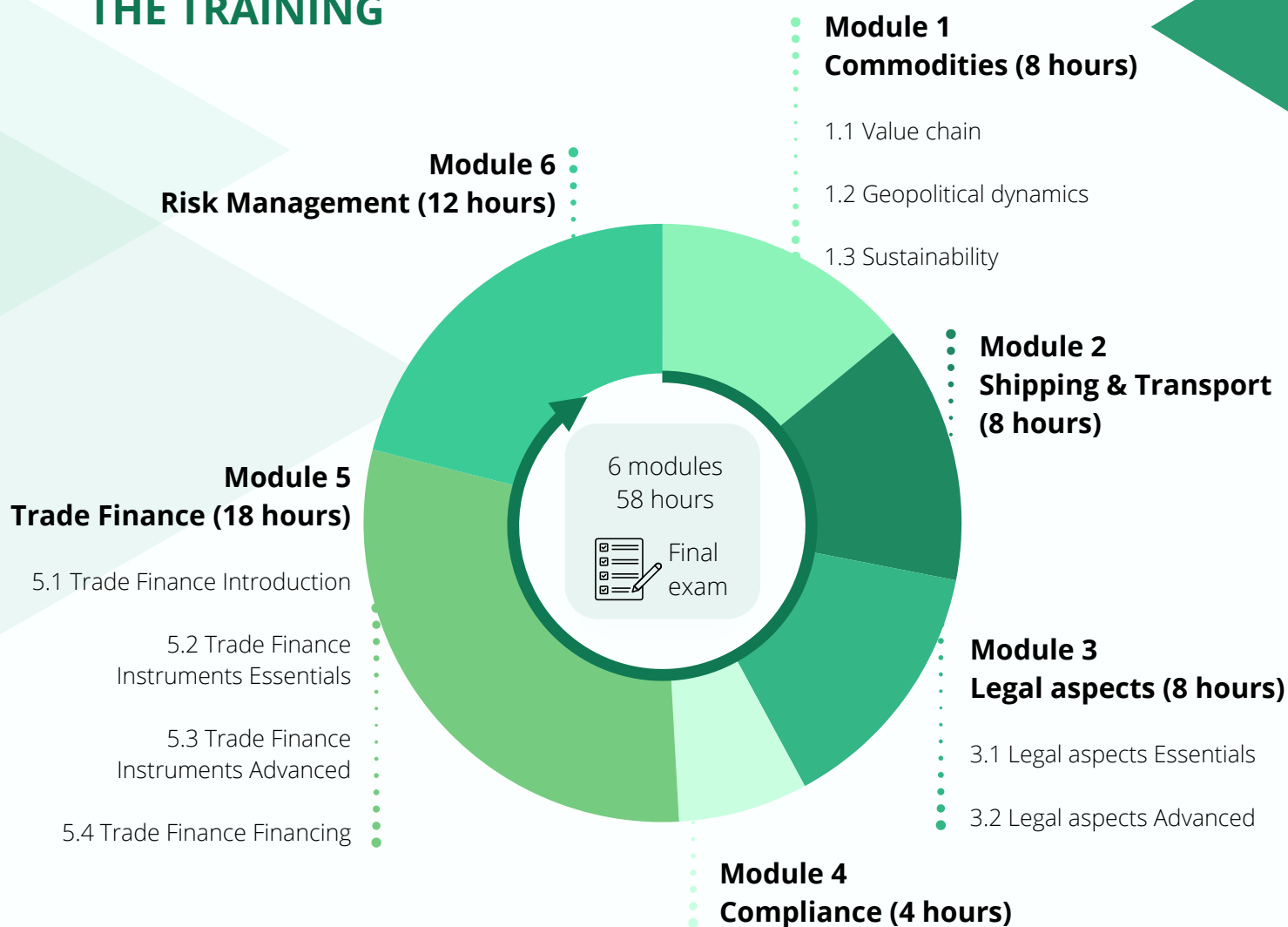


Lugano Commodity Trading Association

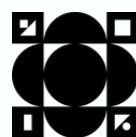
