Professor of Finance and Financial Economics, University of Basel and Member of the Bank Council of the Swiss National Bank



Angelo Ranaldo (*1970) is a Swiss economist and member of the Bank Council of the Swiss National Bank, a position he has held since 2023. He is Professor of Finance and Financial Economics at the University of Basel. Angelo Ranaldo holds a PhD in Finance from the University of Fribourg (Switzerland). Over the course of his career, he has served as Economic Advisor to the Swiss National Bank and as Scientific Advisor to several international institutions, including the Bank of England, the Bank for International Settlements, the International Monetary Fund, the European Money Market Institute, and the European Central Bank that granted him the Duisenberg Fellowship. He was also Visiting Senior Economist at the Federal Reserve Bank of New York. In academia, he has held visiting positions at Aarhus University in Denmark and at the Stern School of Business of New York University. Prior to his current role in Basel, he was Professor of Finance and Systemic Risk at the University of St. Gallen. In addition to his professorship, Angelo Ranaldo is Senior Chair at the Swiss Finance Institute and Adjunct Professor at the University of Zurich.
