Ambassador Ettore F. Sequi is an Italian diplomat and international affairs expert with extensive experience in geopolitics and multilateral affairs. Since joining the Italian diplomatic service in 1985, he has held several senior diplomatic positions, including Consul in Tehran, Counsellor at Italy's Permanent Mission to the United Nations in New York, Deputy Chief of Mission in Tirana, Ambassador of Italy to Afghanistan, European Union Special Representative for Afghanistan and Pakistan, Head of the EU Delegation to Albania, and Ambassador of Italy to the People's Republic of China. He later served as Secretary General of Italy's Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation until February 2023, after previously acting as Chief of Staff to three Italian Foreign Ministers.

Today, Ambassador Sequi serves as Chairman of Sorgenia, one of Italy's leading green-tech energy companies, Vice Chairman of SACE, Director of the Treccani Geopolitical Atlas, Head of the Italian Delegation to the Board of Governmental Representatives of the Einstein Telescope project, and Secretary General of ECAM (European Corporate Council on Africa and the Middle East).

Ambassador Sequi has received numerous distinctions, including the Knight Grand Cross of the Order of Merit of the Italian Republic, the Spanish Order of Isabella the Catholic, Afghanistan's Gold Medal of the Order of Ghazi Mir Bacha Khan, and the 2012 Giuseppe Dossetti Peace Prize.
